## I can convert a measurement into different units

- We will work together as a class to figure out how many of one liquid measure are equal to another. Record below what we find out.

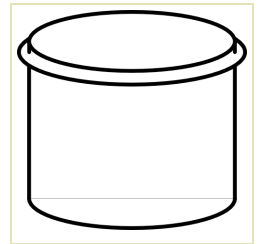
1 gallon = \_\_\_\_\_ quarts

## Conversion cards game

Use the conversion cards to find the answer to each of the following:

- 1 cup, 1 pint, and 1 quart in cups =
- 3 cups, 2 pints, and 2 quarts in cups =
- 2 cups, 3 pints, and 1 quart in pints =
- 4 cups, 1 pint, and 2 quarts in pints =
- 8 cups, 2 pints, and 1 quart in quarts =
- 2 cups, 3 pints, and 3 quarts in quarts =
- 6 cups, 1 pint, and 2 quarts in gallons =
- 5 quarts, 5 pints, and 2 cups in gallons =

# Conversion Practice

## How many cups is that?

*Please record your work mathematically. For example, you might write:*

*3 pints + 1 quart = 7 pints = 14 cups*

*You will not get credit for just an answer.*

1. If I have three pints, how many cups is that?
2. If I have two quarts, how many cups is that?
3. If I have a pint and two quarts, how many cups is that?
4. If I have three cups, two pints, and one quart, how many cups is that all together?
5. How many cups is one gallon?

## How can I use the least units?

*Please record your work mathematically. For example, you might write:*

*11 cups = 1 cup + 5 pints = 1 cup + 1 pint + 2 quarts*

*You will not get credit for just an answer.*

6. If I have to measure out 8 cups, how can I do that using the least number of units?
7. If I have to measure out 7 cups, how can I do that using the least number of units?
8. If I have to measure out 13 cups, how can I do that using the least number of units?
9. If I have to measure out 27 cups, how can I do that using the least number of units?
